Admission Prices

The host district admission prices will be used.

- WCD III Admission Prices:

- Football / Week 10
 - League hosting games 1, 2, 3 – host keeps gate
 - League hosting games 4, 5, 6 – revenue shared

Roster Size

Schedule Changes

Any game, match, meet changes will be authorized by the District Directors or their designee.

Seeding Committee

A seeding committee will be used to place teams into tournaments. The seeding committee shall have the following 9 members:

- 1 League President from each of the 3 leagues
- 1 Sport Commissioner from each of the 3 leagues
- 1 coach from each league appointed by the Sport Commissioner of each league

Sport Commissioner

Each league will designate a sport commissioner for each sport. The Commissioner shall attend sport specific meeting(s).
